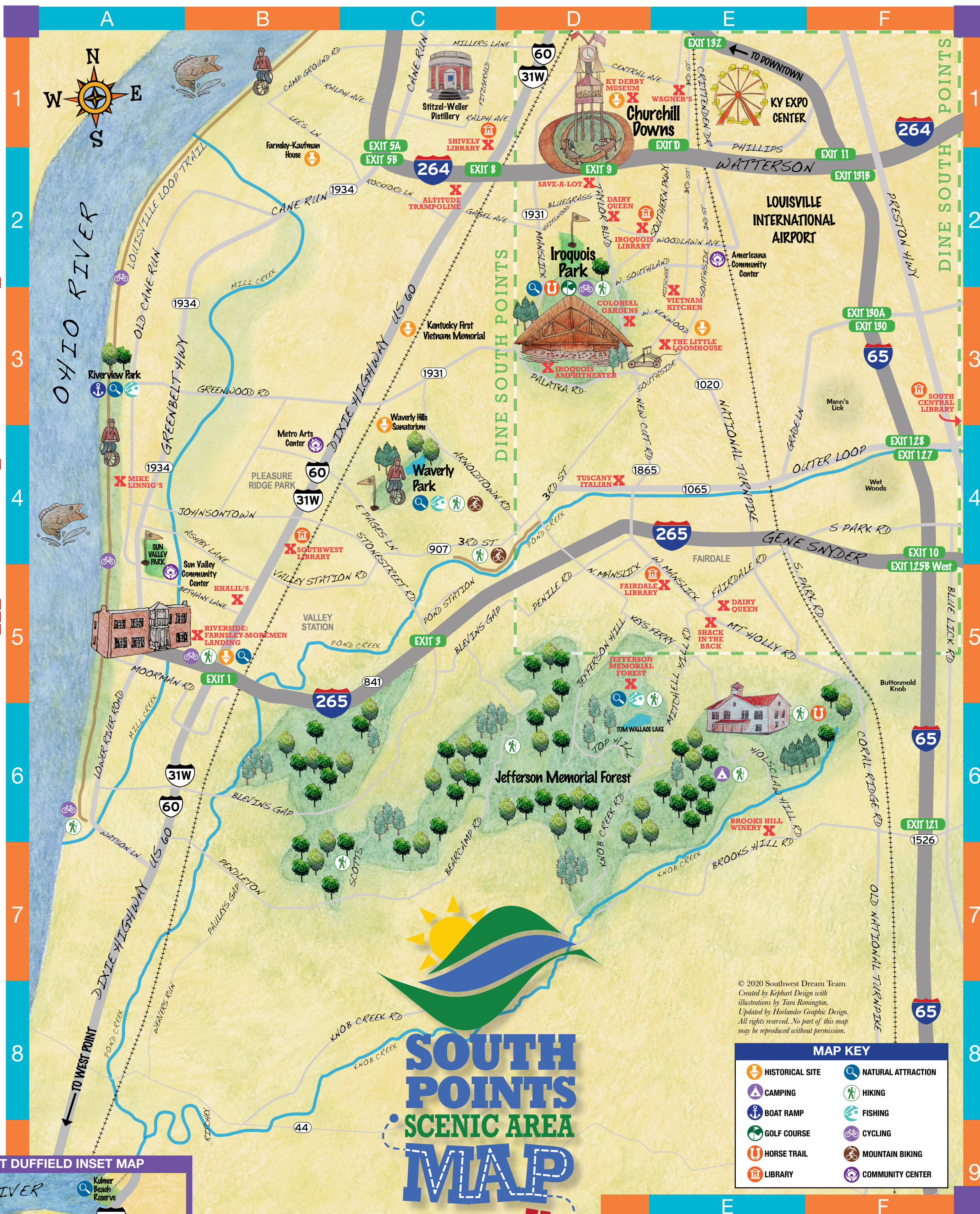

**DID YOU KNOW?** The Farnsley-Kaufman House dates to 1811. The original two-story log house was built by David and Sarah Farnsley at present day Cane Run Road and Lees Lane. The Kaufman family owned the property for several decades. The house is now part of the Farnsley Middle School campus and a nonprofit organization works to preserve it as a community and school resource.

**DID YOU KNOW?** Did you know that Louisville is building a 100+ mile paved path to connect its wonderful parks and neighborhoods to each other? Yes indeed, and when the Louisville Loop is completed, the stretch in southwest Louisville will pass through the knobs, the shale lowland, and the Ohio River Valley floodplain, three of Louisville's five physiographic regions. What's more, a large stretch is already constructed from downtown Louisville along the Ohio River past Riverview Park and Riverside to the Mill Creek Power Station with plans to extend it to Jefferson Memorial Forest and points east. Trailheads are located at Riverside, Riverview Park, and the end of Watson Lane.
